Founding Investment Opportunities

The Redwood Coast Chamber Foundation (RCCF) is a 501c3 nonprofit in formation fostering inclusive economic and community development for California's North Coast. As a result of our work, local businesses, nonprofits, schools and community members have access to expanded programming designed to support regional economic growth and resilience.

Current RCCF initiatives include Leadership Redwood Coast and Next Level. Additionally, RCCF will serve as a fiscal sponsor for other North Coast Chambers of Commerce. As 501c6 nonprofits, Chambers of Commerce are not eligible for most funding opportunities, thus are often limited in the services and programs they can offer. With RCCF's fiscal sponsorship, local Chambers across the North Coast will have opportunity to expand their programs that align with our mission and serve local communities.

With the capability to be nimble and responsive, and a deep commitment to collaboration, we are in active conversations about additional potential opportunities including: support of Latino-owned businesses and organizations; helping place North Coast students in work-based learning opportunities; a collaborative program to engage diverse, locally-owned businesses in the offshore wind supply chain; and building business and nonprofit disaster resilience. These initiatives, and potentially others, will be developed as funding and human resources become available.

Leadership Redwood Coast

Launched in 2023, Leadership Redwood Coast (LRC) is a five-month regional leadership fellowship centered on empowering diverse individuals throughout Humboldt, Del Norte, and adjacent Tribal lands with the tools, connections, and insight they need to effect equitable and innovative change in their communities and across the region.

With 30 cross-sector emerging and established leaders per cohort, LRC runs March through July annually. Created in collaboration with North Edge (formerly AEDC) and Illuminated Marketing, LRC is now housed with RCCF.
