Here at the Chamber we are navigating this new environment along with you and this is where we stand today:



- After discussions with our Executive Committee, our board and committee meetings have started to be hybrid (some participants in person and others virtually)
- After consulting our staff, our office employees have a choice of wearing a mask if they are vaccinated and must still wear a mask if not vaccinated and not distanced in their private office
- Mixers will soon be moving back to in person, and we are navigating ways to hold them hybrid
- Business HQ - Flex Work space is now opening for clients after we discuss our office protocols
- Our office is open to our members and general public to meet with staff and we are considering group meetings on a case by case basis

Creating our reopening plan has required a tremendous amount of internal assessment, and we take into consideration that we will have to be flexible based on situations that we cannot control.






